



Female Reproductive System

Primary Sex Organs for two sexes

- Gonads
 - Ovaries in female
 - Testes in male
- Gametes
 - Ovum or eggs in female
 - Sperms in male



Chromosomes

Chromosomes

- **Autosomes**
 - 46 Chromosomes, 23 Pairs in somatic cells
 - Diploid (2N)
- **Sex chromosomes**
 - 23 chromosomes in gametes
 - Haploid (1N)
 - Female: XX chromosomes
 - Male: XY chromosomes

Function of Female Reproductive System

- A. Production of eggs
- B. Site of fertilization and fetal development
- C. Fetal nourishment, birth and lactation
- D. Secretion of hormones (estrogen and progesterone)






Ovarian Follicles




Uterine (Fallopian) tubes




The Uterus




Uterine wall:



Mammary glands




Lactating breast




Development of germ cell

- C. Secondary oocyte (n)




Endoscopic View of Ovulation

If sperms are present in the fallopian tube:




Female reproductive cycles:

1. Ovarian cycle
2. Uterine/Menstrual cycle

Ovarian cycle:

- Associated with maturation of egg every month.
- Ovulation
- FSH and LH and estrogen regulates it.
- Three main events:
 - Follicular phase, ovulation, luteal phase





Figure 28.14b

Menstrual Cycle




